

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION
ORDINANCE # 2025-006**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF WAYNETOWN, INDIANA CODE OF
ORDINANCE BOOK, TITLE V, PUBLIC WORKS, CHAPTER 50 ELECTRIC,
APPENDIX A ELECTRIC UTILITY RATES AND CHARGES**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Waynetown, Indiana, as both the legislative body and utility service board of the Town, has determined that current fees and charges of the Town's electric utility should be increased to better reflect the actual costs to the utility of those services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WAYNETOWN, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Appendix A of the Town's Electric Utility Rates and Charges is hereby amended to replace the applicable rate or charge below in ~~strike through~~ and instead adopt the rate in **bold**:

Deposit for all new customers and landlords	\$150.00	\$250.00
Deposit for garage service	\$7.50	\$7.50
Reconnect charge for non-payment	\$25.00	\$75.00
Voluntary disconnect charge (eg, out of town)	\$25.00	\$25.00
Voluntary reconnect charge (eg, out of town)	\$25.00	\$25.00
Requested meter test	\$25.00	\$50.00
Dishonored/NSF payment bank charge	\$25.00	\$25.00

Second dishonored/NSF payment in one calendar year: No further payment of utility bills by customer's check will be accepted

Section Two. All rates and charges not changed above or amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section Three. Miscellaneous Provisions.

(a) The findings and determinations set forth in the preambles to this ordinance are hereby made findings and determinations of the Council.

(b) The provisions of all prior ordinances inconsistent with any of the provisions contained in this ordinance are hereby repealed.

(c) The subsequent invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

(d) This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after publication.
